The project was impacted like all Erasmus + projects by the pandemic but the consortium nevertheless has worked to allow the project to stay on course and on its roadmap. Online meetings allowed the collective of partners to continue the momentum.











On 1st of August, the IO1 production concerning the guide of local stakeholders of climate change and managed by ITG was completed and validated;

The platform (IO2 managed by ENAIP) is structured and ready to accommodate content;

The main training modules concerning the impacts of climate change have been decided (IO3 managed by MCE & IFRTS) and the framework for developing the learning contents is now adopted;

The IO4 managed by UNESSA about social cohesion has made it possible to collect nearby 30 good practices, local and collective actions responding to challenges of climate change, in all partners' countries.

The system put in place is intended to be integrated since it plans to reuse clothing that cannot be offered, for the manufacture of various items (bags, dresses, caps, etc.) for resale. Fabric Republic brings together associations, creators, Greek and European volunteers, as well as people with disabilities in a social and environmental project.
