AND TESTING PHASE

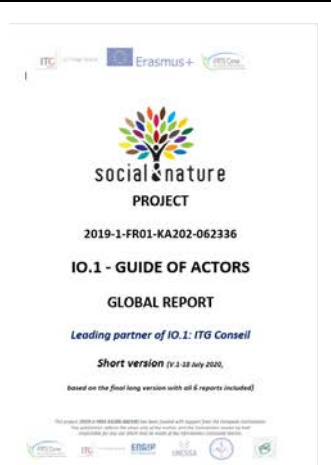
This summer newsletter aims to discuss the following aspects:

I- THE PROJECT'S PRODUCTS

The project's 5 productions have progressed at a good pace, despite the pandemic and measures that have restricted meetings between partners.

The **Actors' Guide** (IO.1, piloted by ITG Conseil) has already been finalized and translated into the languages of the partnership.



The **Platform** (IO2, piloted by ENAIIP) is structured and ready to host content; it is as follows:

Competences

Competences are defined as a combination of knowledge, skills and attitudes, where:

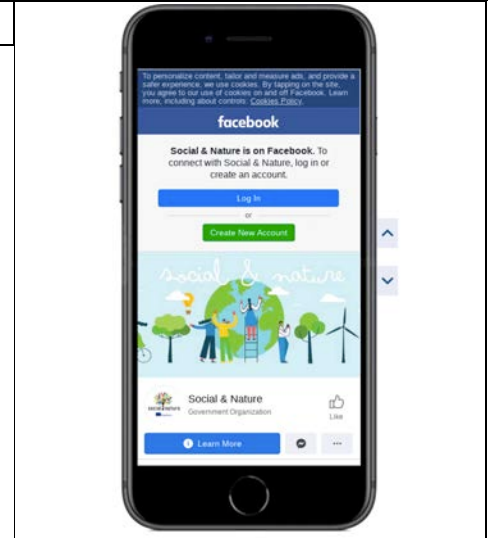
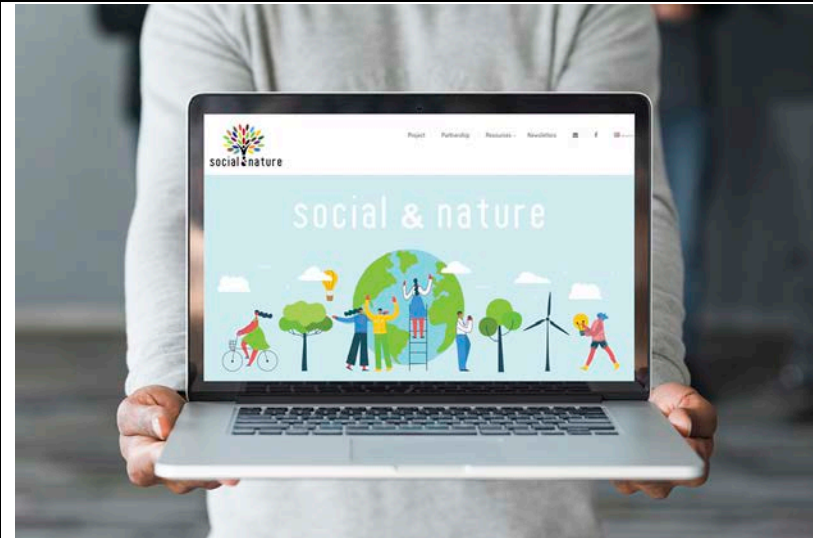
- 1 **knowledge** is composed of the facts and figures, concepts, ideas and theories which are already established and support the understanding of a certain area or subject;
- 2 **skills** are defined as the ability and capacity to carry out processes and use the existing knowledge to achieve results;
- 3 **attitudes** describe the disposition and mind-sets to act or react to ideas,

The **Modules of training on the impacts of climate change** (IO3, led by MCE and IFRTS) are being produced. Newsletter 4 will provide more information on the content of these modules.

The **E-E-Et. Of Good Practices from Social Cohesion** (IO4 led by UNESSA) contains nearly 30 good practices, local and collective actions to combat climate change, across all partner countries.

Work on the **Pedagogical Tool box** (IO5, piloted by ITG Conseil) will be carried out from March 2021.
